Every NJVS™ student is taught by a NJ certified teacher who interacts with the student providing extra help and encouragement to assist the student to successfully complete the course.

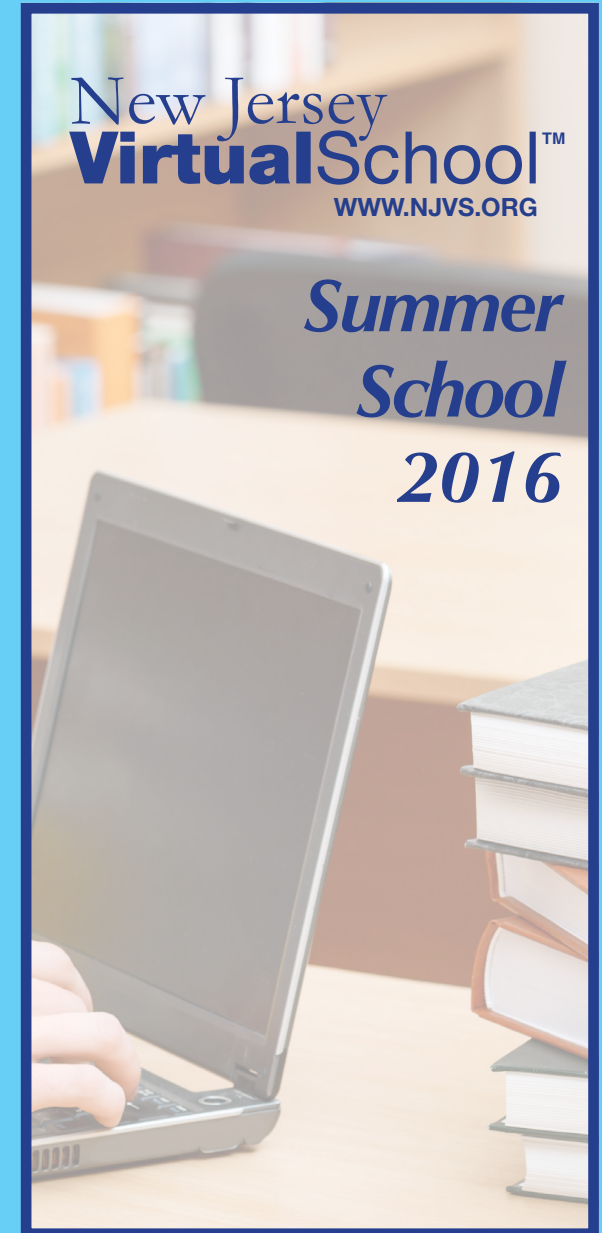
All courses are aligned to the Common Core Standards and instructional pace can be modified by the teacher to accommodate differentiated learning.
